Responsibilities

- Establish procedures to capture, process and supply data and information that supports decision-making in sourcing and production, logistics, and other areas of the enterprise affected by international trade.
- Establish and implement procedures to ensure compliance with regulations governing the movement (export and import regulations) of Limited Brands, Inc. ("LBI") merchandise from U.S. locations; and between foreign locations.
- Monitor entry performance and implement processes as necessary to meet performance standards set by leadership for timely entry and release of goods at foreign locations.
- Design specialized management reports and develop decision support systems as required, including exception based compliance monitoring reports.
- Facilitate use of, and benefits from, trade preference programs through information collection and dissemination, effective management procedures, and training within the business units, Global Trade Compliance, Limited Logistics Services, and other functional areas as required.
- Manage and develop associates responsible for specialized trade information and services and import/export services; including quota and similar trade programs, trade preference programs, and other trade facilitation topics.
- Monitor trade actions and product lines to provide early visibility of trade sanctions that might affect the enterprise, and work with the Customer Service Managers and business units to ensure appropriate planning results, meet compliance goals and to minimize negative impact.
- Manage working relationships with service providers, including customs brokers, to ensure required global service levels are maintained.
- Serve as liaison between Limited Technology Services and Limited Brands Customs Services by assisting in translating business requirements to a technical perspective and overseeing testing of technical systems specifications.
- Encourage and support work teams organized around the importing/exporting needs of specific Brands.
- Partner with Customer Service Managers and Brand associates to ensure that the needs of assigned Brands are met and specified service levels are maintained.

Qualifications

- Knowledge of U.S. Customs laws and regulations and entry procedures.
- Familiarity with retail industry procurement and distribution systems.
- Must be well organized and detail orientated.

- Strong written and oral communication skills including ability to prepare detailed written reports, conduct efficient meetings and deliver effective presentations.
