RESULTS OF QUOTA OPENING

COMMODITY

Specialty Sugar

The tariff rate quota for specialty sugar that opened on Wednesday, October 24, 2007, over-subscribed at opening moment. The pro rata percentage is: **16.87649%** or **0.1687649**.

REPORTING INSTRUCTIONS:

Entries or withdrawals for consumption for specialty sugar presented after the opening should be returned to the broker for amendment.

To facilitate release of shipments, HQ Quota will not allow filers to re-transmit amended entries. Filers should submit corrected CBP-7501s, and the ports will update the entry summary line information. It may be necessary to add additional lines in order to accurately reflect the amendment. Port personnel are reminded that the line item information should reflect the quantity taken, not the quantity presented; for detailed instructions, see chapter IV of the Quota/Visa Reference Handbook.

The importer has the option to distribute the prorated allocation on a given entry, i.e., more or less than the prorated amount, or none at all. The importer may also transfer the allotment to entries at another port. However, in any of these scenarios, the importer may not enter quantities in excess of the prorated amount that was properly presented at opening.

HQ Quota will release the requested amount for each line based on the proration request submitted by the filer. CBP may not release the merchandise until quota input is complete and in accepted status in ACS.
