All brokers, importers and other concerned parties are reminded of CBP policy regarding requests for changes to CBPF 5106/Importer of Record information when the record has a valid continuous bond on file.


If the Importer of Record number requiring an update or change is covered by a valid continuous bond, all requests for changes/updates must be sent to the National Finance Center in Indianapolis for processing at the address listed below. In addition to the updated CBPF 5106, a bond rider will be required.

All requests to update/change Importer of Record data covered by a valid continuous bond submitted within the Area Port of Cleveland will be returned to the sender for submission to the NFC.

Updates/changes to any other Importer of Record (not subject to a valid continuous bond) data contained in any CBP automated system may continue to be submitted to the port of entry or the Area Port Office. In addition, ABI filers have the ability to transmit CBPF 5106 directly to Customs and Border Protection and importer/filers with ACE access have the ability to transmit these via the ACE portal.
